

Public Notice

The purpose of this notice is to seek public comment on the development, design and construction of the **Richmond & Danville Greenway and Spur Trail and the Tobacco Heritage Trail**. The Tobacco Heritage Trail is a regional system of non-motorized multi-use trails to be constructed on primarily abandoned railroad corridors within Brunswick, Halifax and Mecklenburg counties. The Richmond & Danville Greenway and Spur Trail will be constructed on the former R&D railroad in South Boston and Halifax County. The Spur Trail will be located on the former rail spur that served the Cotton Mill and is now owned by the town of South Boston. Funding has been requested from the Department of Conservation and Recreation (Recreational Trails Program) and the Virginia Department of Transportation (Enhancement Funds). The town of South Boston, Roanoke River Rails to Trails and the town of Lawrenceville are the applicants.
